After further consideration of the request of certain land owners of Langley, we have decided to run an alternate line from some suitable point in the neighbourhood of Tynehead to Fort Langley, and from thence to another suitable point connecting it with one of the lines at or about the cheese factory on the Fort Road.

I think you understand this proposition pretty thoroughly, and I shall be obliged if you can at an early date run the line in question.

I do not know that it is necessary to be very particular about anything further than the grades, that is, not to exceed 3% at any point, and at the same time keeping under that figure as much as it is possible to do so.

Be good enough to let me know about how soon you can undertake this work, and oblige,
