Simon Fraser Outdoor Club -Re: Canoe Race

Stating that a canoe race is to be held on the Fraser River on September 28th and 29th and the participants will arrive at Fort Langley between 4: and 5: p.m. on September 28th and will leave on the morning of September 29th. The letter requested that assistance be given to the organizers in finding suitable campsites and other accommodation.

On motion of Aldermen Booth and Barichello this letter is to be forwarded to the Fort Langley and District Board of Trade asking them to assist the Club in finding necessary facilities.

Lower Mainland Regional Planning Board -Re: Railway Link to Roberts Bank

Enclosing a copy of the briefs and other presentations to the public meeting held on August 28th, which had been held to hear representations regarding the proposed railway link to Roberts Bank. It would appear that most municipalities were opposed to the route chosen by the B. C. Hydro Authority and a further board meeting is to be held in Burnaby on September 12th, when this matter will be discussed further.

This report was received on motion of Aldermen Barichello and Shuster.

Vancouver-Fraser Park District -Re: Glenwood Park

Asking the municipality to transfer the land contained in Glenwood Park to the District for inclusion in the proposed Campbell River Regional Park. The letter indicated that the transfer of this land would be at a nominal fee and also stated that a map of the area, showing the lands already purchased and other lands to be purchased, was enclosed with the letter, however, this map could not be located.

On motion of Aldermen Booth and Barichello a letter is to be forwarded to the Park District asking what is meant by a nominal price and, also, asking for the map to be forwarded. The Park District is also to be asked if the park will continue to be available for the use of the public after ownership is transferred.

Mr. Vic Marco - Re: Assessment

Lodging complaints regarding the method of assessment of property similar to the complaint lodged by Mrs. Marco in person.

On motion of Aldermen Blair and Woolley this matter was referred to the Assessor for a report to Council.

Department of National Revenue -Re: Boundary Road

Stating that the suggestion contained in the Council's letter that an alternate route for Boundary Road be considered around the Customs Port of Entry at Aldergrove be discussed with the local officials. The names of the officials to be contacted were contained in the letter.

Fort Langley District Board of Trade -Re: Flyash Problem

Referring to the fact that this problem has still not been abated and asking for further action on the part of Council.

On motion of Aldermen Woolley and Shuster representatives of the McDonald Cedar Products Ltd. are to be invited to meet with the Council on September 30th and a copy of this letter from the Board of Trade is to be forwarded to the Company.
