Regional Park District

The Chairman read a letter from the Secretary of the Park District Board, and this letter did enclose the map that was omitted from the previous letter.

The map showed the land to be acquired from the municipality and land already owned by the Park District together with other proposed acquisitions. The transfer of the park to the Regional Park District would be for the nominal consideration of \$1.00 and the Park District would be willing to lease this land back to the municipality for \$1.00 per year.

On motion of Mayor Poppy and Alderman Blair, Glenwood Park is to be transferred to the Vancouver-Fraser Regional Park District for the sum of \$1.00 and the Park District is to be asked to keep this park available for lease back to the municipality at some future date.
