Mr. H. Pettipas - Re: North-
West Langley Firehall

Stating that he understands the Fire Department has recommended the granting of the contract to Grovesfield Construction Limited. The bid of Grovesfield was \$328.00 higher than the one submitted by Mr. Pettipas. Some press reports would indicate that the contract had already been awarded.

Mayor Poppy stated that the Council usually relies on the Fire Departments for advice in connection with Fire Department business and stated that a contract had not yet been awarded by Council.

On motion of Aldermen Blair and Barichello a joint meeting between the Municipal Council and representatives of the North-West Langley Fire Department is to be held to discuss this matter.

B. C. Epilepsy Society -
Re: Epilepsy Information Week

Lower Mainland Regional Planning Board -
Re: Transfer of Regional Planning

Giving details of the programme for the transfer of the Regional Planning function from the Lower Mainland Regional Planning Board to the individual regional districts. The letter also included copies of proposed letters patent providing for this transfer to take place.

Fort Langley and District Board of Trade -
Re: Railway Crossing Signals

Referring to the crossing signals over the C.N.R. Railway at Glover Road, and asking the Council to initiate action for these railway crossing signals to be improved. Mayor Poppy pointed out that Glover Road is a provincial highway and perhaps the Department of Highways should be involved in discussions on this proposal.

On motion of Aldermen Barichello and Woolley the Traffic Engineer of the Department of Highways is to be contacted regarding this proposal as submitted by the Fort Langley and District Board of Trade.

Langley Secondary School - Re: Citizenship Award

Asking the Council to make its annual citizenship award in 1969. Mayor Poppy noted that this item had already been included in the Provisional Budget and ordered the correspondence filed.
