Department of Highways -
Re: C.N.R. Crossing - Glover Road

Stating that consideration is being given to certain changes in the road pattern at this location in Fort Langley to permit the installation of a better signalling device.

This information was received on motion of Aldermen Breier and Jensen.

Re: Computer Service

Offering the services of this Company on a contract basis in connection with assessment rolls, tax rolls and voters' lists.

Department of Lands - Re: Foreshore Lease
Fort Hotel

Asking if the municipality has any objection to the renewal of this lease.

On motion of Aldermen Jensen and Blair the Department is to be notified that this municipality has no objection.

A Petition Containing 12 Signatures -
Re: 84th Avenue (East of Carvolith)

Requesting the half mile construction of this road and offering to pay fifty percent of the cost. This was tabled pending receipt of a report from the Superintendent regarding the cost of constructing this road.

Fort Langley and District Board of Trade -
Re: Roberts Bank Railway

Asking the Council to ensure that overpasses will be provided on all major roads in the municipality. Mayor Poppy pointed out that the Council has been negotiating with the B.C. Hydro Authority regarding the question of crossings, but it is apparent there will be no overpass on the Livingstone Road or the River Road. However, the planning at the present time indicates there will be an overpass on the Rawlison Crescent.

On motion of Aldermen Breier and Blair a reply is to be forwarded outlining the situation as it exists at the present time.

Lower Mainland Regional Planning Board -
Re: Future Planning

Providing information on discussions that are being carried out at the present time regarding the future of the Planning Board and staff and also the question of the planning function which is to be undertaken by the four regional districts. Mayor Poppy explained that the Executive of the Planning Board has held discussions with the Greater Vancouver Regional District regarding the possible transfer of the Planning Board staff to that regional district, but no reply has been received to date. The correspondence was ordered filed.

Playhouse Theatre Company - Re: Grant

Requesting a grant of \$1,000.

On motion of Aldermen Jensen and Blair no action is to be taken on this request.

Mr. W.V. Sigalef - Re: Medd Road Extension

Requesting the extension of this road and enclosing the sum of \$400. towards the cost. Mayor Poppy observed that Doctor Middleton had previously asked for the extension of this road and had indicated the possibility of some contribution.

On motion of Aldermen Blair and Barichello, Dr. Middleton is to be notified of the recent offer and asked if he is willing to make a contribution towards the cost of this road.
