PUBLIC WORKS SUBCOMMITTEE

The Public Works Subcommittee held a meeting in the Municipal Hall, Murrayville, B.C. on Wednesday, March 5th, 1969 at 10:00 a.m.

Present Were:

Alderman Woolley (Chairman) Mayor Poppy, Aldermen Blair and Jensen.  
The meeting was also attended by the Superintendent of Works and the Municipal Clerk.

Roberts Bank Railway Link

It was reported that notification has been received from the Minister of Commercial Transport that he has chosen the original location for this railway. Contact has been made with the Engineers, who are planning the construction of this railway link, and further negotiations will be carried out with these Engineers.

Traffic Signs - ReflectORIZING

The Superintendent reported that the Motor Vehicle Act was amended in 1966 which requires that all traffic signs be properly reflectorized by December 31st, 1969. Some reflector material has been used on some of the municipal signs, but they do not conform with the requirements of the Act. The Superintendent then presented a report showing the cost of various types of signs and the cost of reflectorizing the signs.

Recommendation - It is recommended that the municipality purchase a reflectorizing machine at a cost of \$54,500 and also purchase one hundred metal stop signs at a cost of \$9,50 each. The signs will be progressively replaced with proper reflectorized signs.

Police Office

Sign -

Mayor Poppy reported a request from Sergeant Maguire for a V shaped sign to be placed in front of the police building and also that some of the brush in the corner lot be cut to improve visability. The Sergeant also requested that "Police - One Mile" signs be placed on the Fraser Highway, both east and west of the police building.

Yard Light -

Sergeant Maguire also requested a yard light to be installed on the front parking lot of the police building.

Recommendation - It is recommended that a yard light be provided on the parking lot and the brush be cut in the corner of the property, and that the Department of Highways be asked to install "Police - One Mile" signs on the Fraser Highway.

Partitions -

Mayor Poppy stated that some office partition walls will be required in the main office of the police building to accommodate the two police detachments after April 1st, 1969. It is expected this will be carried out by the municipal carpenter.
