PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE

A meeting of the Public Works Committee was held in the Municipal Hall, Murrayville, B. C. on Monday, February 23rd, 1970.

Present Were:

ACTING SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

The Acting Superintendent presented his report which is attached to these minutes as Schedule No. 1.

The following action was taken on items contained in the report:

268th Street (North of 32nd Avenue)

On motion of Aldermen Barichello and Breier this was referred to the Public Works Subcommittee for consideration.

Boundary Road (208th Street to 200th Street)

On motion of Aldermen Jensen and Shuster no action is to be taken on this request.

Hillcrest Water System

On motion of Aldermen Breier and Shuster no further extensions of this water system will be contemplated for at least one year from this date.

The Acting Superintendent's report was received on motion of Aldermen Jensen and Breier.

OTHER BUSINESS

Roberts Bank Railway

The Chairman reported that the Commercial Railway Department does not require signal arms to be provided at crossings except where there is a double track. In fact, the signal arms have proved to be a traffic hazard, and have been removed from other single track crossings. Most of the other requests, submitted by the municipality, will be carried out with some modifications.

Wix Road Drainage

The Chairman reported the receipt of a report from the Ditches and Watercourses Engineer, Mr. M.J.J. Dayton, and this report proposes a ditch on private property adjacent to the existing 331 Hubbard Road.

On motion of Mayor Poppy and Alderman Barichello the people in the benefitting area, as outlined by Mr. Dayton, are to be invited to a meeting to discuss this matter.

Public Works Expenditures

The expenditures for the 4 weeks ended January 28th, 1970 were presented and received on motion of Aldermen Breier and Barichello.
